The structure of the IB curriculum relies on the latest pedagogical research and allows teachers to support and develop each individual student's learning. This structured approach allows teachers to use the school's context to create relevant, engaging learning situations that can be practised both in and outside the classroom. The teachers support student learning by guiding the questioning and providing strategies and skills on how to find solutions. Personalised learning is achieved when students actively seek to find the solution to a larger contextual problem or issue and understand its relevance to them.
